

# The Barnyard: Butterfly Feeders:

## Items Needed:

- \* Baby Food Jar
- \* Foam / wood Flower shape
- \* Sponge or cotton
- \* Pipe Cleaner
- \* Low temp hot glue gun & glue
- \* Sticker, Markers or paint



## Instructions:

1. Glue flower to top of jar lid with hot glue gun. Let it cool! (completed)
2. Create a hole through the flower and lid with nail and hammer or drill (completed)
3. Twist one end of the cotton or sponge and push it through the hole so it sticks out about a 1/2 inch.
4. Decorate the flower with bright colors.
5. Wrap the pipe clear around the jar just below the lid. Twist the end to the rest of the pipe cleaner until it is tight!

Mix 1/4 cup of sugar with 1 cup of water boiling water and stir until it is well mixed. You can add a couple drops of food coloring too! Let it cool and then pour into the jar. Hang your feeder!
