

The Barnyard:

EAGLE PUPPET:

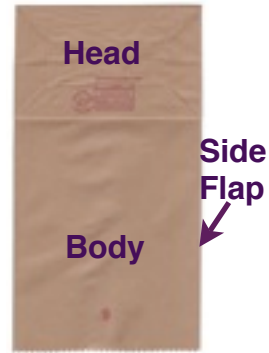
MATERIALS NEEDED

- a paper lunch bag
- some crayons,
- scissors
- glue



GET FAMILIAR WITH YOUR PAPER BAG:

- On one side, it's all smooth. This is the **BACK**.
- On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is the bottom of the bag). This is the **HEAD**.
- Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath of the tab will be the **MOUTH**,
- Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (The 3/4 or so of the bag below the part with the flippy tab) This will be the **BODY**.
- Look at the sides of the bag. This is the **FLAP**.



ASSEMBLE YOUR PUPPET:

- Color the **FLAP** of the paper bag white.
- Glue the feather tuft to the top of the **HEAD**
- Glue the eyes onto the **HEAD** under the feathers.
- Glue the beak under the eyes. It will likely hang down over a little bit of the **BODY**. Make sure you just put glue on top of the beak (where it touches the **HEAD**) so you don't glue the mouth shut.
- Glue the wings into the **FLAP**.
- Glue the feet onto the bottom of the **BODY**
- Glue the tail onto the **BACK**.

The Barnyard:

COW PUPPET:

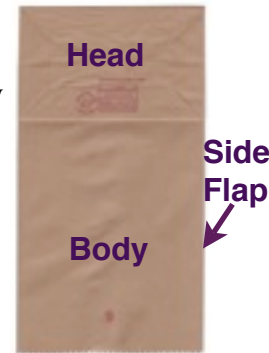
MATERIALS NEEDED

- a paper lunch bag
- some crayons,
- scissors
- glue



GET FAMILIAR WITH YOUR PAPER BAG:

- On one side, it's all smooth. This is the **BACK**.
- On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is the bottom of the bag). This is the **HEAD**.
- Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath of the tab will be the **MOUTH**,
- Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (The 3/4 or so of the bag below the part with the flippy tab) This will be the **BODY**.
- Look at the sides of the bag. This is the **FLAP**.



ASSEMBLE YOUR PUPPET:

- Glue the nose onto the **HEAD**. It should line up with the bottom of the flippy tab.
- Glue the eyes onto the **HEAD** above the nose. If you like, you can use wiggly eyes instead of the paper template pieces.
- Glue the ears onto the sides of the **HEAD**
- Glue the horn onto the top of the **HEAD**
- Glue the tongue underneath the flippy tab so you can see part of the circle sticking out from under the nose.
- Glue the tummy onto the **BODY**.
- Glue the arms into the **FLAP**.
- Glue the tail onto the **BACK**.

The Barnyard:

GIRAFFE PUPPET:

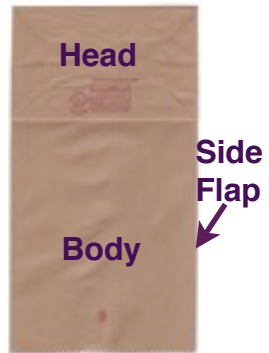
MATERIALS NEEDED

- a paper lunch bag
- some crayons,
- scissors
- glue



GET FAMILIAR WITH YOUR PAPER BAG:

- On one side, it's all smooth. This is the **BACK**.
- On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is the bottom of the bag). This is the **HEAD**.
- Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath of the tab will be the **MOUTH**,
- Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (The 3/4 or so of the bag below the part with the flippy tab) This will be the **BODY**.
- Look at the sides of the bag. This is the **FLAP**.



ASSEMBLE YOUR PUPPET:

- Color the bag yellow.
- Glue the tongue underneath the flippy tab.
- Glue the nose (a big oval) onto the **HEAD**. It should overlap the body a bit.
- Glue the eyes onto the **HEAD** above the nose.
- Glue the "horns" onto the **HEAD**
- Glue the ears onto the **HEAD**
- Glue the hair tuft onto the **HEAD**
- Glue the arms into the **FLAP**.
- Glue the spots onto the **BODY** and the **BACK**.
- Glue the tail onto the **BACK**

The Barnyard:

OWL PUPPET:

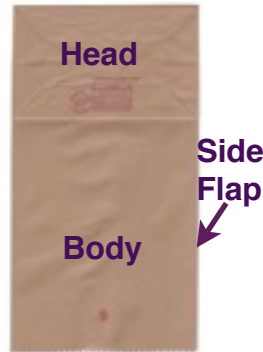
MATERIALS NEEDED

- a paper lunch bag
- some crayons,
- scissors
- glue



GET FAMILIAR WITH YOUR PAPER BAG:

- On one side, it's all smooth. This is the **BACK**.
- On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is the bottom of the bag). This is the **HEAD**
- Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath of the tab will be the **MOUTH**,

- Glue the feather tuft to the top of the **HEAD**
- Glue the eyes onto the **HEAD** under the feathers.
- Glue the beak under the eyes. It will likely hang down over a little bit of the **BODY**. Make sure you just put glue on top of the beak (where it touches the **HEAD**) so you don't glue the mouth shut.
- Glue the wings into the **FLAP**.
- Glue the feet onto the bottom of the **BODY**
- Glue the tail onto the **BACK**.

FROG PUPPET:

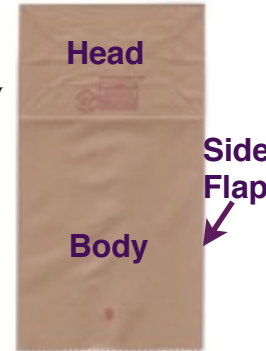
MATERIALS NEEDED

- a paper lunch bag
- some crayons,
- scissors
- glue



GET FAMILIAR WITH YOUR PAPER BAG:

- On one side, it's all smooth. This is the **BACK**.
- On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is the bottom of the bag). This is the **HEAD**
- Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath of the tab will be the **MOUTH**,
- Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (The 3/4 or so of the bag below the part with the flippy tab) This will be the **BODY**.
- Look at the sides of the bag. This is the **FLAP**.



ASSEMBLE YOUR PUPPET:

- Color you bag green.
- Put one of the green circles in front of you. Glue the medium sized (white circle) onto it. Glue the small (black) circle onto that. Repeat with the other set of circles. Now you have two eyes!
- Take the red long rectangle and wrap it around a pencil to give it a curl. This will be the tongue.
- Glue the eyes onto the top of the **HEAD**. You can see from the photo above that the eyes stick up over the top of the head.
- Lift the **FLAP** and glue the tongue underneath.
- Glue the arms into the **SIDE FLAP**. When you do this, glue or tape them onto the top of the flap

The Barnyard:

LION PUPPET:

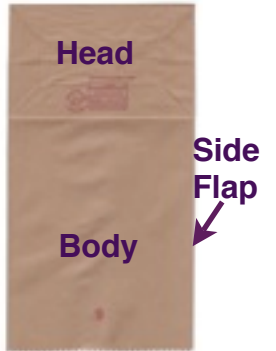
MATERIALS NEEDED

- a paper lunch bag
- some crayons,
- scissors
- glue



GET FAMILIAR WITH YOUR PAPER BAG:

- On one side, it's all smooth. This is the **BACK**.
- On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is the bottom of the bag). This is the **HEAD**
- Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath of the tab will be the **MOUTH**,
- Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (The 3/4 or so of the bag below the part with the flippy tab) This will be the **BODY**.
- Look at the sides of the bag. This is the **FLAP**.



ASSEMBLE YOUR PUPPET:

- Color the bag yellow or keep it brown.
- Glue the tongue underneath the flippy tab so you can see it.
- Glue the nose, eyes and ears onto the front of the flippy tab to make the face. **HEAD**.
- Glue the eyes onto the **HEAD** above the nose. If you like, you can use wiggly eyes instead of the paper template pieces.
- Glue the teeth to the **HEAD** or on the flippy tab.
- Glue the ears onto the **HEAD**
- You can gut out a mane from brown construction paper if you want to make a female lion or leave it as it is and make a female one.

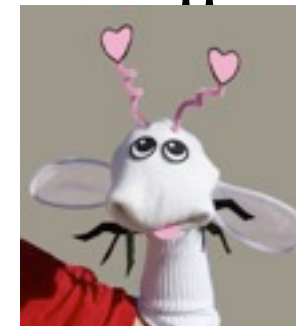
